

The Guidelines & instructions for recruitment Medical Officers for Palle Dawakhanas

- 1) Recruitment shall be done for 1677 Medical Officers vacancies at Palle Dawakhanas in State.
- 2) Applications may be invited by the respective District Selection Committee headed by the District Collector from Medical Officers-MBBS.
- 3) Selection shall be done for Medical Officers posts with MBBS Qualification on contract basis.
- 4) List of Palle Dawakhanas
Medical Officers Positions will be filled up at Palle Dawakhanas as per the list enclosed.
- 5) The remuneration shall be fixed as per G.O.Ms.No.510, HM&FW (D2) Department, dated 05.09.2018.

6) UPPER AGE

The Upper Age limit shall be reckoned as on 01-07-2021 with the following relaxations allowed for reckoning the maximum age limit as per rules:

8) Method of Recruitment

Recruitment shall be done by the District Selection Committee on behalf of the District Health Societies. The District Selection Committee shall consist the following:

9) Selection will be done on Merit Basis

Selection will be done on Merit basis, based on the following criteria:

- (i) Total marks are 100 of which 90 marks will be allotted basing on the marks obtained in qualifying examination and 10 marks will be awarded for the age. 0.5 mark will be awarded for one completed year of age with a maximum of 10 marks.
- (ii) Merit list will be prepared based on the marks obtained with above criteria and displayed on Official website of District Collector, for transparency and also for calling objections.
- (i) Selections list will be prepared from the finalized merit list duly following the Rule of Reservation (RoR) in terms of G.O.Ms.No.196, dated 28-05-2016, G.O.Ms.No. G.O.Ms.No.65, G.A.(Ser.A) Dept., dated : 19.03.2021, G.O.Ms.No.242, G.A.(Ser.A) Dept., dated : 24.08.2021, G.O.Ms.No.243, G.A.(Ser.A) Dept dated : 24.08.2021 & G.O.Ms.No.244, G.A.(Ser.A) Dept dated : 24.08.2021
- (ii) The Selected candidates shall maintain the Headquarters.
- (iii) It shall be noted that these positions are not transferable.

10) Rule of Reservation

- (i) Rule of Reservations in respect of Community, Disability, Ex-Service Men/Women shall be strictly observed as ordered by the Government of Telangana from time to time.
- (ii) The Rule of Reservations to local candidates is applicable as per the Presidential order.
- (iii) The districts should continue the existing Roster.
- (iv) The vacancies for the posts mentioned in G.O.68, falling in Scheduled Areas should be filled exclusively with the Local Scheduled Tribes.
