Applications are invited from the eligible candidates for filling up of the post of **Court Attendant** in Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class Court, Pattikonda.

QUALIFICATIONS :-

- 1 The applicant must not have completed the age of 65 years, who have retired as members of A.P.Judicial Services.
- 2 Any retired person who held the post of Attender, Process Server or in any other post in the last grade services in Subordinate Courts or in the A.P. High Court services is eligible for appointment as Court Attendant.
Provided that if suitable retired employee from Last Grade Service in the subordinates Court and AP.High Court Services does not respond to the recruitment notification or otherwise not available, an outsider can be appointed.
- 4 Who has at least one year to complete 65 years as on the date fixed by the Court in the year of recruitment, shall alone be eligible.
- 5 Provided that if suitable retired employees, from A.P. Judicial Ministerial service and A.P. High Court service do not respond to the recruitment notification of otherwise not available, an outsider will be appointed and they must have not the age of 42 years and must have complete the age of 18 years as on 01.01.2023 and age relaxation in respect of SC/ST,BCs is 5 and P.Hs., Ex-servicemen is 10 years as per rules.

The above applicants shall possess qualification of SSC fail or VII pass for the post of court attendant.

DISQUALIFICATIONS:

1. Any employee who crossed the age limit of 65 years shall not be eligible for the appointment of Court Attendant.
2. Any employee, who has taken voluntary retirement on the ground of Medical invalidation, retired on compulsory retirement from service, Dismissed, or removed from service or subjected to any other major penalty and misconduct, shall not be eligible for the appointment of Court Attendant.
3. Persons who have been dismissed or removed from service or compulsorily retired from service or subjected to any other major penalty and misconduct are not eligible to apply.
4. Persons who have been convicted and sentenced by a Court for an offence involving moral delinquency or is charged of any offence constituting moral turpitude and proceedings are pending are not eligible to apply.


5. Persons of unsound mind or deaf or mute or blind or suffering from leprosy or any other contagious diseases are not eligible to apply.
6. Persons who have been adjudicated as an insolvents or un discharged insolvents are not eligible to apply.

NOTE :

1. The appointments to the post of Court Attendant shall be for a period of two years and if the work of the persons hold the said post satisfactory, such persons may be considered for appointment for the subsequent period subject to age limit, on the performance of work and on physical fitness of the individuals.
2. Preference will be given to the Local candidates i.e., persons living in the same station or near about place and the rule of Reservation need not be followed.
3. Preference will be given to those candidates who have experience in the field.
4. The Court Attendant are eligible for 15 days casual leaves for every calendar year and they are not entitled for any other kind of leave. The concerned Spl. Judicial Magistrate of II Class is authorized to sanction casual leave to the Court Attendant.
5. The District Judge is competent to terminate the service of the person working in the post of Court Attendant at any time if the work is not satisfactory or there is any physical disability or on the grounds of misconduct or negligence.
6. On appointment and while in service a Court Attendant may be removed without being called upon to show cause if he fails to attend the Office without written permission of the Special Judicial Second Class Magistrate.
7. Powers conferred by the Court on the Court Attendants shall automatically stand withdrawn on his attaining the age of 65 years
8. The retired employees of Judicial Department residing at Pattikonda, Kurnool District who are willing to work in the above said post, may apply.

The desired and eligible persons can submit their applications with latest passport size photo duly attested by Gazetted Officer, affixing on the application, to the District Judge, Kurnool with Bio-data particulars and attested copies of relevant certificates (one set) such as date of birth, Education qualifications, post held at the time of Retirement, Medical fitness and Mental alertness certificate etc., along with self addressed postal cover duly affixing Rs.25/- postal stamps worth, to inform the date of interview.

The last date for receipt of applications is 31/1/23 at 05.00 p.m.
Any applications received after above date and time will summarily be rejected.
