- 1.1 Applications are invited through online for recruitment to the Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes Backlog vacancies for a total of 54 vacancies from the candidates of Erstwhile Guntur District, within the age group of 18 - 52 years as on 01.07.2022.
- 1.2 The candidate shall apply online through official website <https://www.gunturap.in/2023> from **28.03.2023 to 11.04.2023**.
- 1.3 The applicant who desires to apply for the above post shall visit the above Website. Once applicant registers his/her particulars, a Registration Number will be generated. It shall be copied and saved for future correspondence.
- 1.4 The selection to the post shall be made on the basis of the **Marks obtained** in the basic qualification as mentioned at Para Number 1.7 of the notification.
- 1.5 The applicant has to visit the respective website for EDIT his/her details till the prescribed timeline i.e. 11.04.2023. Only the details entered in the respective website will be considered for the future correspondence. No individual correspondence will be entertained under any circumstances.
- 1.6 All desirous and eligible candidates shall apply online after satisfying themselves as per the terms and conditions of this recruitment notification. The prescribed mode of submitting online application is through the official website <https://www.gunturap.in/2023> only. Any application submitted through any mode other than the prescribed mode will not be entertained under any circumstances. Submission of application form by the candidate is considered that he / she has read the notification and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down there under.

### **PARA-2: ELIGIBILITY:**

- 2.1 He / She shall be a candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe community.
- 2.2 He/ She shall be a local candidate of **Erstwhile Guntur District**.
- 2.3 He /She must possess the basic qualification and other qualifications prescribed for the post.  
( see para no. 1.7)
- 2.4 His / Her character and antecedents are such as to qualify him/her for such service.

### **PARA-3: EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

The candidate should possess the prescribed academic qualification (as specified at Para Number 1.7) as per the date of this notification. **In respect of other than**



**prescribed Educational Qualifications, claiming equivalence, the decision of the District Selection Committee shall be final.**

**Note:** If the applicant possesses an equivalence of qualification other than prescribed qualification in the SC/ ST Backlog notification, applicant should produce a copy of the Government Orders to the District Selection Committee in advance within 7 days of last date for submitting applications, failing which their application will be rejected.

**PARA- 4 RESERVATIONS:**

- 4.1. There will be reservations in SC/ST Backlog Recruitment in respect of Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes only.
- 4.2. **Caste & Community:** Community Certificate issued by the competent authority in terms of G.O. Ms No. 58, SW (J) Dept., dt.12.05.1997 should be submitted at appropriate time, as per A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules, Rule - 2(28) Explanation. In so far as claiming for SC reservation is concerned, no person who professes a religion different from Hinduism shall be deemed a member of Scheduled Caste. However, Scheduled Caste converts to Buddhism deemed to be Scheduled Caste. BCs, SCs, STs & EWS belonging to other States are not entitled for reservation.

**PARA-5 LOCAL STATUS**

- 5.1 Reservation for Non-local candidates is not applicable as all the posts are reserved for the Local Candidates of the Erstwhile Guntur district only.
- 5.2 Single certificate, whether of study or residence as stipulated in G.O.Ms.No.674, General Administration (SPF-A) Dept., dated:20.10.1975 would suffice for enabling the candidate to apply as a "LOCAL CANDIDATE" and also follow the guidelines laid in G.O.Ms.No.168, G.A. (SPF-A) Dept., dt.10.03.1977.
- 5.3 Candidates who migrated from Telangana to Andhra Pradesh between 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2014 and 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2021 as per G.O.Ms.No. 130, General Administration (SPF & MC) Department, Dated 29.10.2019 and as per terms laid down in Circular Memo No.4136/SPF& MC/2015-5, Dated 20.11.2017 of Government of Andhra Pradesh shall obtain the **Local Status Certificate** from competent authority and produce at the time of verification.
- 5.4 The candidates shall produce study certificates from Class 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> and up to their academic qualification prescribed for the post they have applied for, and also produce any certificates as specified in the existing rules for this purpose to claim their local status.

**PARA- 6 AGE:**

Minimum 18 years & Maximum 52 years as on 01.07.2022

**Note:** No person shall be eligible if less than 18 years and is more than 52 Years

**PARA - 7 HOW TO APPLY:**

- 7.1 The applicant who desires to apply for the post shall visit the website <https://www.gunturap.in/2023>
- 7.2 Go through the instructions furnished in website under "ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS" before filling up of the online application.
- 7.3 By clicking "APPLY ONLINE" you will find "INSTRUCTIONS TO FILL ONLINE APPLICATION" and read carefully the instructions.
- 7.4 After reading the instruction, you'll find "PROCEED TO APPLICATION". By clicking it you'll be forwarded to "APPLICANT DETAILS ENTRY". Select Post applying for and then select the Caste Category and then click on "PROCEED". Now you'll be shown the online application to enter your complete details. Fill up the details carefully and read the declaration and then click on "SUBMIT".
- 7.5 Once Submitted the online application, you'll be shown the "APPLICATION RECEIPT". Print the application receipt and preserve it for future correspondence.
- 7.6 Applicant can check the details submitted online by clicking on "VIEW YOUR APPLICATION".
- 7.7 If any changes in the submitted application, candidate can go to the "EDIT APPLICATION DETAILS" option provided in Home page. After satisfying the details entered, the applicant can take a print of the online application by clicking "PRINT APPLICATION" and preserve it for future correspondence.

**NOTE:**

**A.** Online Application Registrations and Edit Application Details are permitted from **28.03.2023 10:00 AM to 08.04.2021 05:00 PM** only. Any changes made by the applicant on subsequent dates shall not be allowed.



**B.** The District Selection Committee is not responsible for any mistakes made by the applicant while submitting the application online. Hence applicants must strictly follow the mentioned instructions before submitting the application.

**C.** Incomplete/incorrect applications will be rejected. Any information submitted after the specified timeline will not be entertained by the District Selection Committee under any circumstances. If any mistake made by the candidate during scrutiny is detected, their candidature will be rejected even at the final stage of the recruitment process or even at subsequent stages and may also be liable for punishment.

### **PARA - 8: PROCEDURE OF RECRUITMENT**

- 8.1 The Process of Recruitment shall be made by the District Selection Committee.
- 8.2 There shall be No Written examinations and Interviews (Oral Tests) as per G.O. Ms.No. 126 & 127 General Administration (Services-A) Department dated: 19.10.2022.
- 8.3 The Selection of the candidate will be made only on basis of the marks obtained in the basic qualification as specified in Para Number 1.7.
- 8.4 Merit will only be considered on the marks obtained in the basic qualification as prescribed in Para Number 1.7. If any School / College / University issues certificate in terms of GPA, CGPA other than the method of marks, the Grade Points Average obtained therein will be calculated to 100 percent to determine merit. (Eg: if a candidate gets 8.4 GPA/CGPA, it will be calculated as 84%. In case, the respective school / college / university converts the same GPA/CGPA to marks percentage as 79%, this percentage will only be considered for merit). Apart from the above mentioned methods, if any School / College / University awards letter grades like A+, A, B+, B,... etc., OR A1, A2, B1, B2 ... etc., OR other grades like 1<sup>st</sup> Class, 2<sup>nd</sup> Class, ... etc., It is the responsibility of the candidate to obtain the marks list from the School / College / University concerned and only those marks should be submitted in the online application.
- 8.5 If the marks obtained in the basic qualification as specified in Para Number 1.7 are entered incorrectly in the online application, the candidature will be rejected.
- 8.6 If two or more candidates get equal total number of marks, The oldest being considered for admission. In case there is tie in age, the person who possesses educational qualification at earlier date would be considered.
- 8.7 Proficiency Test in Office Automation with usage of Computer and associated Software shall be conducted for the Shortlisted Candidates for the post of Junior Assistant/Typist/Junior Steno vide G.O.Ms.No.133, General Administration (Services-D) Department dated: 12.05.2014. The above Proficiency Test is a qualifying test. The Marks obtained in the Proficiency Test shall not be included in calculating the Merit
- 8.8 The appointment of selected candidates will be subject to their being found medically fit in the appropriate medical examination and if he/she is of sound health, active habits and free from any bodily defect or infirmity.
- 8.9 The details of various stages of the recruitment process, important dates and other information will be posted on the website and the same information will not be shared through any other media. All the candidates should know the relevant updated information by visiting the website frequently.
- 8.10 In case more candidates apply than the number of vacancies mentioned in the notification for the posts for which the basic qualification is "reading and writing in Telugu or English language" as mentioned in para 1.7, the eligible candidates will be selected by conducting a Read & Write Aptitude Test. The venue and dates of the Aptitude Test will only be published on the website from time to time and information will not be shared through any other mode of communication. So all the candidates must know the relevant information by visiting the website frequently.

### **PARA -9 IMPORTANT LEGAL PROVISIONS GOVERNING THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS:**

- 9.1. Vacancies: The recruitment will be made to the vacancies notified only. The number of vacancies mentioned above may vary. There shall be no waiting list.
- 9.2. The Recruitment will be processed as per this notification and also as per the Rules and Instructions issued by the Government and also as decided by the District Selection



Committee from time to time.

- 9.3. The whole recruitment and selection process is carried out with utmost regard to transparency, so as to ensure that the principle of merit is scrupulously followed.
- 9.4. The persons already in Government Service/ Autonomous Bodies/ Government Aided Institutions etc., whether in permanent or temporary capacity or as work charged employees are however required to inform, in writing, to their Head of Office/ Department that they have applied for this recruitment.
- 9.5. A candidate shall be disqualified for appointment, if he/she, himself/herself or through relations or friends or any others has canvassed or endeavored to enlist for his candidature, extraneous support, whether from official or non-official sources for appointment to this service.
- 9.6. The Degrees obtained through Open Universities / Distance Education mode must have recognition by the Distance Education Council, Government of India. Unless such Degrees have been recognized by the Distance Education Council. they will not be accepted for purpose of Educational Qualification. The onus, in case of doubt of Proof of recognition by the Distance Education Council. that their Degrees / Universities have been recognized, rests with the candidate. Candidates may also refer G.O.R.T.No.143, Higher Education (EC) Dept., Dated:11.07.2018 and the Supreme Court judgment dated:03.11.2017 in this connection.
- 9.7. The Telugu copy of the notification is not a literal translation of the English notification. It has been given for the convenience of the candidates. English copy should be taken as standard if there is any translation error in Telugu.

In the G.O. first read above, an adhoc rule was issued to fill-up all the backlog vacancies of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes duly waiving the written examinations including interviews (oral test) for the Limited Recruitment to be conducted by all Recruiting Agencies except the Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission and the selection shall be made only on the basis of marks obtained the qualifying academic examinations passed by the candidates, so as to fill up the identified backlog vacancies. The time limit is being extended from time to time to fill up the backlog vacancies of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes up to 31.03.2022.

2. Government have decided to extend the time limit for filling up the backlog vacancies of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes as on date, for a further period up to 31.03.2023.

3. Accordingly, the following notification will be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette:-


In the said Adhoc rule, for the expression "before 31st March, 2022", the expression "before 31st March, 2023" shall be substituted.
