About ABP Fellows:

1. What is Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP) Fellowship?

Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP) Fellowship harnesses the energy, talent, and passion of young fellows from reputed institutions towards achieving the goals of ABP, namely, inclusive growth, community empowerment, and building a prosperous India for all.

2. What will be the roles and responsibilities of ABP Fellows?

The ABP Fellows will be positioned as a critical link between the Block level Officials and NITI Aayog. Their primary responsibilities will include:

- a) Collaborating with Block level Officials to design and execute development strategies aligned with ABP thematic areas.
- b) Conducting regular field visits to assess project implementation, address challenges, and collect ground-level insights.
- c) Analyzing data and providing evidence-based recommendations to BLOs. District level Officials to optimize developmental initiatives
- d) Organizing workshops, awareness campaigns, and skill-building programs to empower the local community,
 - e) Keeping States and NITI abreast with the issues, challenges and need for support
 - f) Help in the documentation of good governance practices.
 - g) Use the ABP portal to assess the performance of the block and communicate to all the Block level Officials.
- h) To connection-board every single government employee in the block to the Karmayogi GOT portal including cutting edge employees like ANMs, Anganwadi Sevikas etc.
- i) To attend all the training programmes conducted by NITI, State or District to send reports at regular intervals to the DM/DC/CDO/CEO/BDO/State Nodal Officer/NITI regarding the performance of the Block
- k) To work under the overall guidance of the DM/DC/CDO of the District and report to BDO for their every day functioning.

3. What will be the stipend of ABP Fellows?

Each ABP Fellow will receive a monthly stipend of Rs. 55,000/-. The stipend amount will be sent to district account from NITI Aayog directly.

4. What will be the tenure of ABP Fellows?

The tenure of Aspirational Blocks Fellows will initially span of one year with budgetary support from NITI Aayog. The program allows for a one-year extension of the fellowship, contingent upon the fellow's satisfactory performance and demonstrated contributions to the program's objectives, and paid for by the State Governments for the 2 year from their State budgets.

5. What is the eligibility criteria for ABP Fellows?

- a) Post Graduate in any discipline from a reputed institution
- b) Should possess data analysis and presentation skills
- c) Should be conversant with use of social media
- d) Should possess Project Management Skills
- e) Experience of working/internship with a Development Organisation
- f) Self-driven with good communication skills.
- g) Knowing the local language of the respective Aspirational Block is a requirement for all Aspirational Blocks Fellows.

Eligible candidates should submit their application on a plain paper with all the requisite documents along with the application to the O/o District Economics and Statistical Office, Collectorate, Parvathipuram Manyam through registered post or by directly on or before 5.00 P.M of 10.11.2023.
